Not hearers only

[HOLD 2 SECONDS]

If you love me

> You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. And you shall love your neighbor as yourself.

> If you love me, keep my commandments.

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> *— John 14:15*

> All authority has been given to me in heaven and on earth. Go and make disciples of all nations, teaching them to observe all things that I commanded you. Behold, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.

Sheep without a shepherd

> When he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion for them, because they were harassed and scattered, like sheep without a shepherd.

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> Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is indeed plentiful, but the laborers are few. Pray therefore that the Lord of the harvest will send out laborers into his harvest."

[HOLD 3 SECONDS]

A cheerful giver

> He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly. He who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully.

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> Let each man give as he has determined in his heart, not grudgingly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.

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> *— 2 Corinthians 9:6–7*

> Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

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> *— Matthew 6:21*

> Most certainly I tell you, this poor widow gave more than all those who are giving into the treasury, for they all gave out of their abundance, but she, out of her poverty, gave all that she had.
